**Improvement Program for Computed Axial  
Tomography (C.A.T.) Studies and Emergency  
Care at the Children's Hospital in Tamaulipas**



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# Project Objective

To enhance diagnostic and emergency care capacity by:

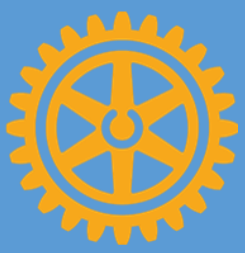
- Supplying the hospital with CAT scan contrast-enhanced injector systems.
- Providing radiolucent stretchers and modern surgical lighting for the 2 emergency rooms.
- Training medical staff for operation and maintenance.
- Assuring the equipment and supplies with a maintenance policy included and management commitment.



# Community Needs

- Currently, pediatric patients who require C.A.T. studies with contrast must be transferred to other hospitals or laboratories, delaying care up to five days.
- C.A.T. studies with contrast-enhanced require external transfers with the impact in delays in the diagnosis and quick attention.
- The emergency area lacks radiolucent-transparent stretchers and adequate ceiling lights. These deficiencies limit timely and effective attention during emergencies.
- Emergency rooms lack of radiolucent stretchers and ceiling lighting.
- Results: Delayed diagnostics, limited care quality, higher medical risk and extra costs for studies. Savings will be use to buy supplies.
- The hospital serves as the only specialized pediatric facility in the state.



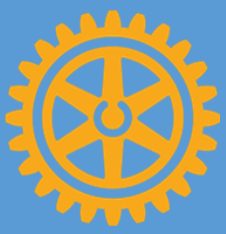

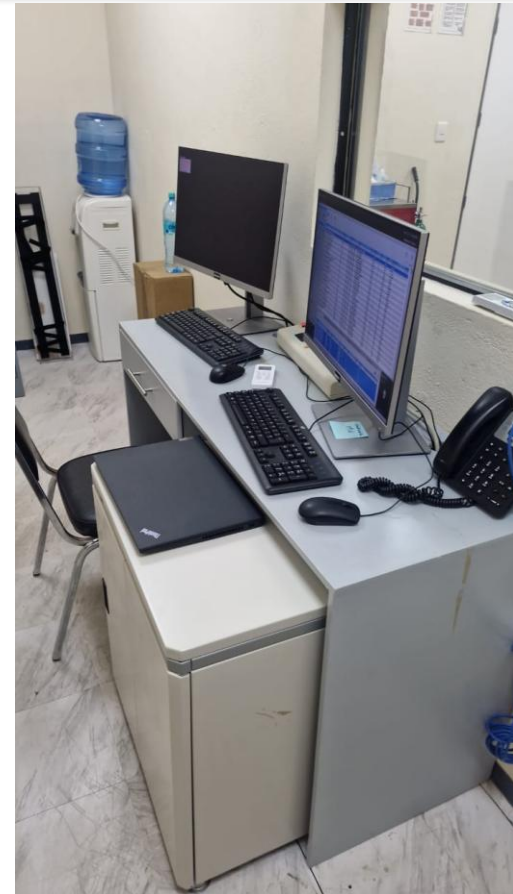


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**C.A.T. ACTUAL EQUIPMENT IN OPERATION**



**C.A.T. ACTUAL OPERATIONS SYSTEM**

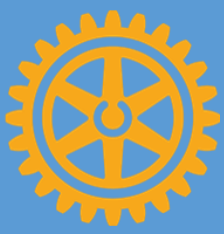

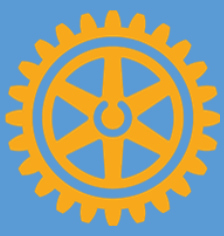

# Sustainability



The project includes:

- It will provide 50 studies per week, it is more than 2,000 studies per year savings a lot of time for the diagnosis, discomfort for patients and their families and money for transport and pay for the study to other hospitals and/or labs. Minimum cost per test outside de Hospital is \$150 = \$300k savings + the trip cost per year.
- A maintenance service contract. The actual C.A.T. already has a maintenance service multiannual contract.
- A long-term technological upgrade plan.
- Continuous medical staff training, including cascading education for residents and new residents.
- The hospital administration commits to maintaining the operational budget for critical supplies and to providing periodic reports on clinical indicators.
- The hospital administration commits to buy all the supplies to use properly and all the time the C.A.T. See the letter signed by the General Hospital Manager.
- The children's parents will not wait long to know what is the diagnosis.
- The “Voluntad against Cancer ONG” (operate some of our projects there) and Parents will pressure to the Hospital to assure the correct equipment operation.

Regarding the project on the needs at our Children's Hospital of Tamaulipas, which we have been working on with your Rotary Club Ciudad Victoria, for the provision of the following equipment, materials, and supplies:

1. Equipment to have a contrast media injector for the Phillips C.T. Scanner currently in operation.
2. Supplies to perform 100 C.T. scans using the new injector with contrast media.
3. Two radiolucent stretchers for the two emergency rooms.
4. Two LED ceiling lights for the two emergency rooms.

Through this letter, we hereby commit, as the Institution and Collaborating Organization of the Project, to include in our 2026 annual budget the necessary supplies to use the injector provided by this project, and to ensure that C.T. scans with contrast media are performed. We also commit to providing ongoing training to the technicians who currently operate the C.T. Scanner, as well as to resident doctors and trainees assigned to the hospital, so that they learn to use the C.T. with contrast media.

Regarding maintenance, we commit to including it in the current C.T. maintenance contract or contracting the required maintenance as stipulated by the manufacturer's and/or distributor's warranty policy, to ensure the sustainability of the equipment service and the achievement of project objectives.

Regarding the two stretchers and two lights for the emergency rooms, we commit, as the Institution and Collaborating Organization, to train the doctors and nursing staff who receive children in these areas to properly use and care for all four pieces of equipment, ensuring their longevity and sustainability in accordance with their expected lifespan, and to carry out the maintenance as specified in the equipment manuals.
