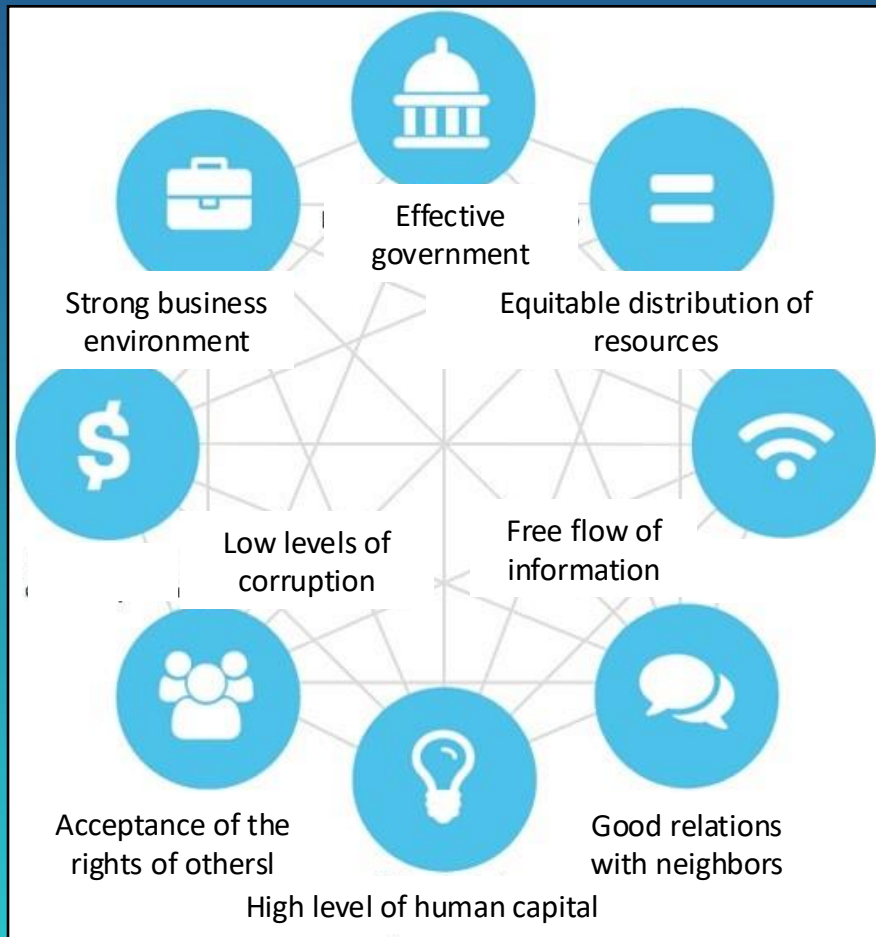
PEACE AND CONFLICT PREVENTION

OBJECTIVE

Provide young people and mentors with comprehensive training in various disciplines that will enable them to acquire the skills required in today's world, using an innovative blended learning model, that is student-centered and practical in approach, and developing positive peace in their communities.



PEACE AND CONFLICT PREVENTION



GOALS

Empowering individuals and communities to transform conflicts and build peace.

Train community members in areas such as: communication, logical and critical thinking, comprehensive health, and leadership for peacebuilding and improving personal development.

Using the indicators derived from the ten pillars of positive peace.



IMPACT

Enhance young people's skills in preventing and resolving conflicts in complex situations, and generate tangible ways to improve peace measures in their communities.

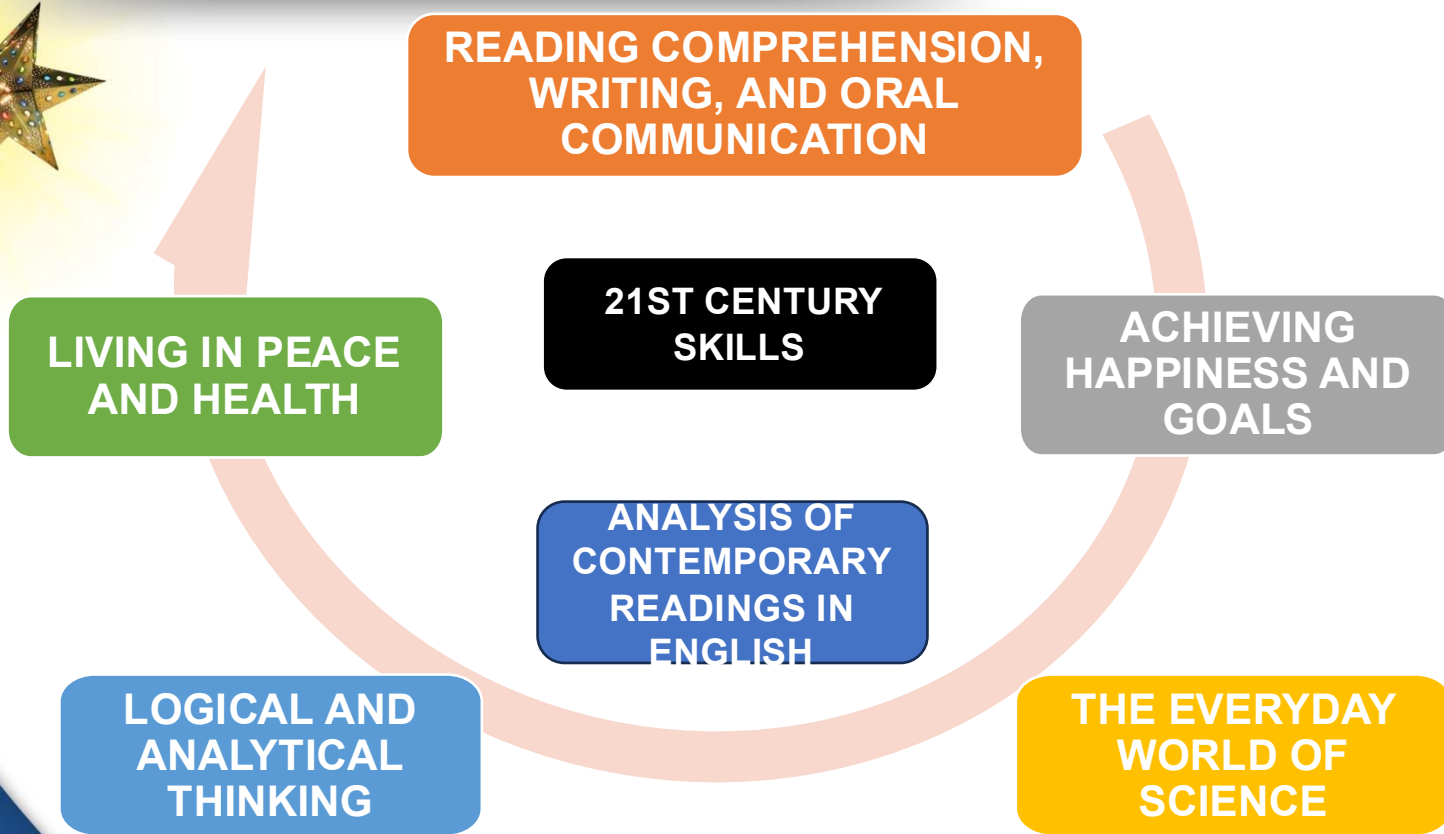
TARGET POPULATION 90 HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AGED 13 TO 18 IN THE COMMUNITY OF TEMOAYA

EXPECTED IMPACT:

90 young people and their families,
18 mentors, their families, and students
Approximately 1,000 people in total



ACADEMIC CURRICULUM



Young people lack the basic skills needed to face a modern world that demands their participation in society.

DURATION: 3 semesters

3 MODULES: 6 monthly courses

COURSES: 18 courses on specialized critical topics

GROUPS: 3 groups of 30 students each

DESIGN: By volunteer specialists from the country's top universities

MODEL: B-Learning, In-person and distance education with a theoretical-practical approach.

PARTICIPANTS: 90 young people aged 13 to 18 and 18 mentors

- **The municipality of Temoaya in the State of Mexico** (with 105,766 inhabitants) is currently “**the homeland of the Otomí people.**” one of the most important ethnical communities surviving from prehispanic México.
- **Participatory mapping with:** municipal and educational authorities
- **Surveys were administered** to 514 high school students.
- **The needs according to the results are:**
 - ✓ Comprehensive training for young people and mentors to build positive peace in Temoaya.
 - ✓ Carry out community projects for peacebuilding and conflict resolution.
 - ✓ Knowing, reading, writing, understanding, and communicating in Spanish and English.
 - ✓ Leadership skills.
 - ✓ Improving relationships with parents and neighbors.
 - ✓ Reducing violence in the community.
 - Training in values.
